TICKETING – Tickets will now be pre-sold and allocated seats are bought on line through trybooking.com

Participating students – tickets can be purchased through Try Booking and the children will be seated within their school area.

Parents and Spectators – can also purchase tickets through Try Booking. These tickets are **ALLOCATED** seats and a certain number of seats are

available directly behind your children. This method will give you a full block of supporters. Once these tickets are sold, there are additional **ALLOCATED** seats available in the blocks which are located at either end of the Arena.

DRESS CODE - It is preferred that girls wear dresses or skirts and boys in long trousers and collared shirt. Many boys like to borrow a tie or bow tie from dad for the occasion. Shoes for girls need to be a sandal style shoe with or without a small heel and for boys, school leather shoes are good, deck or jogger style shoes are acceptable.

CATERING – Please note that if the children require food or drinks, they will need to bring it with them, as they will not be able to leave their school area to go to parents at any time. Security guards will also not allow any commercially prepared food to be brought into the venue. Adults are NOT permitted to bring any alcohol inside the venue.

SECURITY - Once children are in the Arena, they are not allowed outside or upstairs and must remain in their allocated school area. All children must be collected from the Main Arena area by a parent or authorised person. Children will not be allowed to leave the Arena to meet parents outside the venue.

DAMAGES - We ask that all people attending this event take the utmost care of all furniture, equipment and property within your school's reserved area at the venue and at all times. Any damage of any nature will be the responsibility of the school to cover all associated costs.
